## Classroom Snapshot

**Math:** This month, students will be learning how to multiply and divide decimals. We will begin by reviewing how to add and subtract decimals before jumping into multiplication and division. Students will use real world application by working with things like money, sports statistics, and more.

**Social Studies:** Now that students have a better understand of our current government, we will be shifting our focus back to its creation, starting with the colonization of America and the American Revolution. Students will learn what our country was founded on and how the colonists fought for their freedom. We will be studying important historical documents like the Declaration of Independence, the Bill of Rights, and the Constitution.

**Science:** In December, students will be learning all about matter. This unit will cover topics such as solubility, conductors, insulators, and density. Students will get to conduct several hands-on experiments to discover which items conduct electricity, how to compare the density of different objects, and what materials are water soluble.

**Christmas Program Show Times:** This year we will have two performances so that everyone will have an opportunity to see the program. While students will be performing at both program times, family members and friends are asked to choose one program to attend so there is enough room in the sanctuary for all audience members. The first show will be at the beginning of the school day (9 am), and the second showing will be at 12:15 pm (directly following dismissal).
