Classroom Snapshot



Math: This month, students will build on their understanding of multi-digit multiplication as they learn to multiply decimals. We'll also review long division and begin working with two-digit divisors.

Social Studies: We will be wrapping up our unit on states and capitals in class. However, students should continue studying their states and capitals on satellite days to prepare for upcoming assessments. Memorizing all of the states and their capitals takes time, so I want to give students plenty of opportunities to practice. That said, it's important that they are studying diligently each satellite day. Some great study tools you can use at home include flash cards, Seesaw journal assignments, ORBIT binder resources, and online quizzes such as <https://www.geoguessr.com/vgp/3063>.

Science: This month, students will be learning about how energy transfers within ecosystems. They will learn about interdependent relationships between organisms and explore how small changes to an ecosystem can have a great impact.
