Accented Syllables (Long A Patterns)

Generalization: In two-syllable words, one syllable is accented, or stressed. The long a sound in a two-syllable word may be spelled *ai*, *ay*, or *a_e*.

Challenge Word: exclamation

Spelling WordsR-Influenced Vowel Patterns - *ire, ier*

Generalization: *i* combines with *r* to create r-influenced sounds and patterns. The *ire* and *ier* patterns come at the end of a word and represent the long *i* sound. Words that end in *ier* often have base words that end in *y* (cry → crier).
