## Classroom Snapshot



<u>Math:</u> This month, students will be learning how to add and subtract fractions and mixed numbers with unlike denominators. They will practice finding the lowest common denominator and creating equivalent fractions in order to add or subtract accurately. When subtracting mixed numbers, students will learn how to borrow from the whole number as needed. They will also work on writing their answers in simplest form and converting improper fractions back into mixed numbers.

<u>Social Studies:</u> As we wrap up our unit on colonization, we will begin studying the American Revolution, exploring how the colonists fought for their freedom from Great Britain. Our learning will start with the French and Indian War and progress into the key events that led to the American Revolution. Students will learn about minutemen, major battles, and Paul Revere's famous midnight ride. Patriotism takes on new meaning as we reflect on the reasons and events that secured our nation's freedom.


<u>Science</u>: In December, students will be learning all about matter. This unit will cover topics such as solubility, conductors, insulators, and density. Students will get to conduct several hands-on experiments to discover which items conduct electricity, how to compare the density of different objects, and what materials are water soluble.
