
**Bible Verses:** You will find a list of March's Bible verses on the back of the newsletter.

### Classroom Snapshot



**Math:** This month in math, we will be working on classifying polygons. Students will build their math vocabulary as they learn to describe and identify attributes such as parallel, congruent, adjacent, perpendicular, and intersecting sides. We will also focus on classifying triangles based on their angles, exploring the differences between acute, obtuse, and right triangles.

**Science:** We are expanding our studies outside of Earth's atmosphere and launching into space. Students will explore the solar system, focusing on the sun and its effects on the Earth. Students will experiment with shadows and learn how they are affected by the time of day and seasons.



**Social Studies:** We've wrapped up the American Revolution. This month, we will be learning about westward expansion including the Oregon Trail, California Gold Rush, and the Trail of Tears.

Students will also continue working on their wax museum presentations. In class, we will be practicing our wax museum scripts and how to present them like a "wax figure."

**Academic Showcase** In lieu of student-led conferences this year, elementary classes will be hosting an Academic Showcase on Friday, March 27. There will be no regular classes that day. Instead, students will have a Satellite Day so families can come and enjoy the showcase together. Because this falls right before Spring Break, students will come home on Wednesday with three Satellite work packets. These packets will be for Thursday, Friday, and the Monday after Spring Break.



And the earth brought forth grass, the herb that yields seed according to its kind, and the tree that yields fruit, whose seed is in itself according to its kind. And God saw that it was good. <p>March 9<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Gen 1:14–19 (NKJV)</u></p> <p>Then God said, “Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs and seasons, and for days and years; and let them be for lights in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth”; and it was so. Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. He made the stars also. God set them in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth, and to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness. And God saw that it was good. So the evening and the morning were the fourth day.</p>
<p>March 16<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Gen 1:20–23 (NKJV)</u></p> <p>Then God said, “Let the waters abound with an abundance of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the face of the firmament of the heavens.” So God created great sea creatures and every living thing that moves, with which the waters abounded, according to their kind, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good. And God blessed them, saying, “Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth.” So the evening and the morning were the fifth day.</p>
