Classroom Snapshot



IMPORTANT CHANGE: The Wax Museum has changed to Friday, May 1st @ 2pm.

Math: We are getting close to wrapping up our math standards for the year! This month, we will continue working on converting units of measurement, focusing mainly on how to complete conversions within the metric system. We will also be learning about units of time and line plots.

Science: This month, we will be wrapping up our space unit. Students will be learning about the Earth's rotation and how it causes observable patterns such as changes in seasons and the position of the Sun, Moon, and stars in the sky.

Social Studies: We are continuing our unit on Westward Expansion. Students will be learning about the different technological advances during the expansion such as steam engines and the cotton gin. This will lead us into our standards on indentured servitude and slave trade.

Idaho History Museum Field Trip: On Monday, April 27th, 4th and 5th grade are invited to join us at the Idaho History Museum for a field trip. Because field trips are held on Satellite days, attendance is optional. More information, including specific times, will be provided after spring break.

Move-Up Day: This year, Move-Up Day will take place on April 24th. During this time, students will spend 45 minutes with the 6th grade teachers, giving them a glimpse into what they can look forward to next year and helping them feel more comfortable and excited about the transition.
