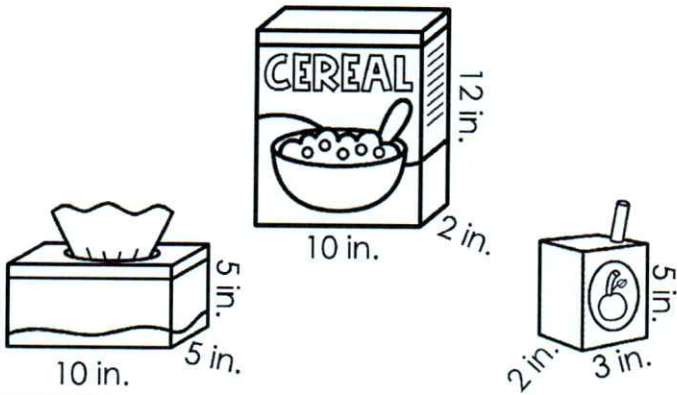

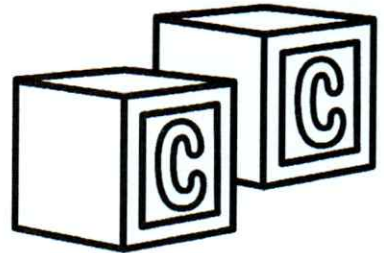
Additive Volume of Prisms Word Problems

1. George is building a tower with a cereal box, a drink box, and a tissue box. What is the volume of the tower?



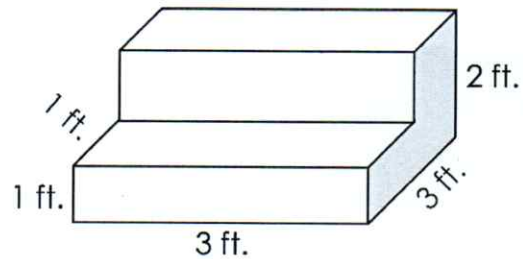
2. The combined volume of two identical cubes is 432 cm^3 . What is the measure of one cube's edge?



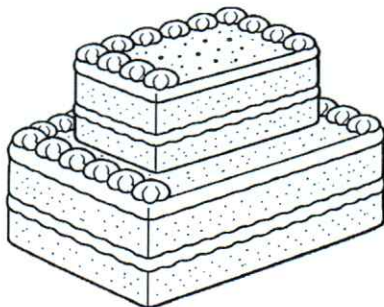

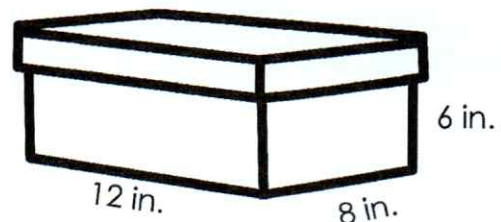
4. What is the volume of concrete needed to build the steps?
